RESOLUTION CITY OF LA PALMA

2005 VETERANS DAY PARADE

By the authority of the Board of Supervisors, the following Resolution is hereby issued:

WHEREAS, November 11, 1918 marked the end of hostilities of World War 1 and this date has now been set aside by our nation as a time to honor our veterans and enlisted men and women of the Armed Forces of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America today embodies the highest ideals of freedom and democracy born out of social and political revolution and tempered by civil war and foreign conflicts; and
